New Preparation Classes for First Holy Communion beginning in September

If you have a child aged 7+ who would like to make his/her first Holy Communion please collect an application form from the office.

New classes will begin in September in the hopes of children being ready to receive this wonderful sacrament in time for Christmas.

New Lectionary for Mass

On the 1st Sunday of Advent this year we will begin using a new lectionary, ie a different translation of the scriptures from that which we currently use. "The new Lectionary will use the English Standard Version – Catholic Edition of the Bible and the Abbey Psalter. The changes are intended to make the biblical translations more faithful to the original languages, biblical scholarship, and to provide a text for use in liturgical setting that is more 'proclaimable' and, where appropriate, more inclusive". Each parish has to purchase new sets of Lectionaries for the Lectern. Lectio

"The Ambo Edition" of the Lectionary costs £695 for four volumes and will be available in October. Each set comes with four stickers that can be inscribed with the names of those who donate to the new liturgical books on behalf of their parish or chapel. If there are four groups / people that wish to sponsor one of the four editions - £174 each – at either parish please speak to Canon Michael.

A Book of the Gospels will cost us an extra £275 but is not available until the middle of October and a Study Edition of the Lectionary is available at a cost of £250.

Please consider donating towards this unavoidable cost. Thank You.
